Provides tutoring by volunteers on a one-to-one basis for youth and adults in basic reading and writing skills, up to a grade 9 level.

Assessments are done to determine student's strengths, best instructional methods and if there is evidence of a learning disability before they are matched with a tutor.

Assessments are also provided to individuals who want to know they are at risk for a learning disability, but do not want to enter the program.

Provides help with short-term or occasional needs.

Is designed for persons whose first language is English or who have a good command of English. It is not designed for those who are learning or have difficulty with English as a new language. A minimum oral benchmark of 3 is required.

Sessions take place at the Literacy Works office or at an agreed upon alternative location arranged by the volunteer and the student.

Students range from those with no literacy skills to adults who have been through the school system, but require upgrading.

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
